## 2<sup>nd</sup> Campus is Underway!

While you may not see it yet, we are already underway in launching our 2<sup>nd</sup> campus. We have a core group of 20 adults meeting, have established a covenant, are praying each day at noon for the Lord to do a great work, and are seeing Him answer those prayers. There are some questions arising about the campus that I want to answer for the entire congregation.

No, we are not buying property right now. Instead of buying and building, we are growing a congregation that will worship in that area first. We will begin with a Bible Study and several outreach and service events to reach new people. Once we reach our benchmarks, we will secure a location and make plans for a weekly worship service. Our goal is to have that service going by October, 2018.

Below is the "manifesto" for the 2<sup>nd</sup> campus, Christ Laurel. I encourage you to read it and pray along with the launch team. This is a mission of the entire church! What an opportunity to help and inspire new people to Say Yes To Jesus!

### Christ UMC Plan for Launching the 2nd Campus:

**Vision:** To reach new people with the gospel of Jesus Christ by launching a new worshipping community.

**Project:** Our object is to launch a 2nd campus of Christ UMC by October 2018 near the intersection of I-75 and Laurel Rd. This area is growing with people moving into new developments. They are the Golden Year Guardians, Booming With Confidence, and Blue Sky Boomers. They match our existing congregation very well. There are no churches on Laurel Rd except a small Congregational Church.

**Kingdom of God Goals:** We want people *Saying Yes to Jesus*. We want new people Saying Yes to Jesus as their Savior and Lord and we want Christians saying Yes to Jesus as they continue to grow as disciples. Our Discipleship Strategy is for people to Worship, Connect, Grow, and Go.

### Benchmarks for progress towards launching 2nd campus:

- 20 adults on launch team to start Bible Study in home/community center.
- Campus pastor named.
- Operational Team meeting monthly for 4-6 hours to do adaptive work.
- 50 adults on launch team with 100 on interested contact list and \$100,000 pledged to secure location.
- Ministry teams in place and trained to set preview service dates.
- 150 on interested contact list to set weekly launch date.
- 200 at launch service moving towards 100 weekly attendance.

# Launch Steps

## Step 1 - Core Group

Identify people within a 2.5 mile radius of the intersection who would become the core group for this campus.  
 Invite them to an informational meeting.  
 Discuss our plan and answer questions.  
 Ask for commitments.

## Step 2 - Covenant

Develop a covenant for the group.  
 Containing elements on Worship, Connect, Grow, Go. Reaching new people.  
 Review benchmarks and progress.

## Step 3 - Bible Study

Launch Bible Study in area.  
 Pick time and location.  
 Use L3 model for meetings.  
 Spiritual Formation Questions, Glory sightings, prayer at each meeting.  
 Bible Study is formational.  
 Led by Pastor Mike and then campus pastor.

## Step 4 - Identify Ministries

Establish teams to meet needs of growing group and future campus.  
 Discover and develop leaders.

## Step 5 - Outreach

Hold outreach and missional events to reach new people in neighborhoods.  
 Serve community.  
 Invite in multiple ways.  
 Identify target areas and neighborhoods.

## Step 6 - Secure location

Rent place.  
 Build out/make adjustments to facility.  
 Get needed supplies.

## Step 7 - Preview Service

Marketing and outreach  
 Soft launch date for friends.  
 Work out kinks for teams.

## Step 8 - Launch Service

Live service with sermon on screen.  
 11:00, Contemporary Service  
 Follow up with new people.  
 Set new benchmarks for continued growth.

## Further Details:

We will be one church in two locations. There will be one budget, one staff, one sermon on Sunday. The second campus will be called Christ Laurel.

The 2nd campus will be integrated with the Christ Venice Campus. Members will be encouraged to participate in programming at both campuses. Youth and Children's programming will be combined.

The campus pastor reports to the senior pastor.

The 2nd campus will have an operational team to handle adaptive work to that campus. The Church Council, SPR, Trustees, Finance, and other leadership committees will be integrated so both campuses are represented.

The Florida Conference will give a decreasing stipend for the campus pastor over 4 years beginning at \$50,000. The rest of the costs are up to Christ UMC. Our current giving works out to be about \$1900 per worshipper a year.

Start up costs for a 2nd campus would include rent, build out, sound and media equipment, chairs and tables, limited staffing, etc.

Neatly trim around each stamp about 1/4 to 1/3 inch, bring to church and drop in the collection boxes in either the Family Life or Memorial Hall Kitchen.
